Electronic 50/50 Rules of Play

1. The lottery will take place at The Toronto Open 2018 Taekwondo Championships games at Variety Village, 3701 Danforth Avenue, Scarborough, Ontario M1N 2G2 on Saturday November 17th, 2018
2. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in Variety 50/50 draws:
 - **Employees of Variety- the Children's Charity of Ontario and Variety Village**
 - **Volunteer ticket sellers**
 - **Intoxicated persons (Alcohol will not be served at this event)**
 - **Persons under the age of 18**
3. Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle systems supplied by Canadian Bank Note Company Limited, an approved vendor of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).

At a cost of: **3 for \$5, 10 for \$10 or 60 for \$20**

4. After purchase, sellers will give the purchaser a receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be assigned.
5. The winning number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw for that day/game.
6. The estimated prize amount of the 50/50 will be shown on two roving backpack screens throughout the building and on the 50/50 sellers hand held devices. There will also be announcements throughout the Championship.
7. The winning number will be announced at the Championships during a break around 4:00 p.m. over the PA system at Variety Village and on the Variety Website within 48 hours www.varietylvillage.ca
8. How to Claim a Prize;

The winner can report to the reception desk or any seller at Variety Village within 30 minutes of the draw announcement or; if the winner is no longer in attendance at the Championship, they may claim their prize by contacting: Issa Ocampo at 416-699-7167 ext 292, or by email at: iocampo@varietyontario.ca the winner must present their winning ticket at Variety Village, 3701 Danforth Avenue, Scarborough Ontario M1N 2G2 for verification at a mutually agreed upon date and time.

9. Winners must have the original winning ticket, copies will not be accepted. **All payments will be made by cheque within 30 days of claiming a prize** in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that game. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.
11. The winning ticket holder has **six months** in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased on, after which the prize will be donated to a charity other than
