Rule of Play for 50/50 Electronic Raffle

Event: Variety Gala 2017- Throwback Thursday

1. 1. The lottery will take place at "The Forth"- 629 Danforth Ave, Toronto, Ontario, during The Variety Gala 2017- Throwback Thursday on November 9th, 2017 between 6:30p.m.-10:00p.m. The winning number will be announced at 10:30p.m. on the main stage, the venues digital screens, and at www.varietyvillage.ca/50-50draw
2. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the 50/50 draw:
 - Employees of Variety, the Children's charity, and Variety Village
 - Volunteer ticket sellers.
 - Persons under the age of 18
 - Intoxicated Persons
3. Tickets are 5 for \$20, 20 for \$50, or 60 for \$100.
4. Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle systems supplied by 50/50 Central, an approved vendor of the AGCO.
5. After buying, patrons will be given a receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System by the sellers. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.
6. The winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw for that day/game.
7. The estimated amount of the 50/50 prize will be shown on the handheld units the 50/50 volunteers and staff will possess. There will also be announcements throughout the event with the updated estimated prize amount.
8. If the patron with the winning number on their ticket is still at The Forth, they may then come to the main stage on the second floor to claim their prize which will be awarded to them via cheque within three weeks of the claim date or;
9. If the winner is not in attendance at the game, or does not wish to claim their prize immediately, they may claim their prize by contacting Zoë Pagazani at 416-699-7167 ext 290, or by email at: zpagazani@varietyvillage.on.ca. The ticket may then be brought to Variety- The Children's Charity head office- Variety Village, 3701 Danforth Avenue, Scarborough Ontario M1N 2G2 at an agreed upon time for ticket verification. **The winner will then be paid by cheque within three weeks of the claim date.**
10. The winning ticket holder has **six months** in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchase for.
11. When a winning ticket is presented, the winner must: show 1 piece of government issue ID proving their age to be over 18, complete the Variety- The Children's Charity (Ontario) 50/50 Prize Claim Form and sign their name on the winning ticket.

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12. The total winnings will be awarded at minimum, 50% of the total reconciled sales for the draw within three weeks of the claim date. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided or the six month time period to claim a prize is expired as outlined in item 13.

13. In the event that no winner comes forward, funds will be held for six months. After that time period has elapsed the prize will be donated to a charity other than Variety- the Children's Charity, with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).
