Who we are:

Located in southwestern Scarborough, Variety Village is an inclusive, adaptive and family friendly facility serving more than 30,000 individuals each year. With approximately one half of its members with a disability, Variety Village has had and continues to have a profound impact on the lives of people with disabilities and their families. Through adaptive sport and recreation programming, outreach and education, Variety promotes inclusion and healthy living through adapted physical activity. Variety Village is seeking several qualified Lifeguards to join our team of talented staff.

Summary:

Variety has partnered with Jay's Care and Challenger Baseball and are seeking a trained coach to lead our new program initiative. Challenger Baseball is an adaptive baseball program for individuals with cognitive and/or physical disabilities. The program helps teach core life skills such as courage, independence, teamwork, and love of sport. The program will be offered as 2 groups- Junior (7-13), and Senior (14+). The successful applicant will coach the 2 groups back-to-back for 1 hour each, paid for 3 hours accounting for setup and cleanup. The coach will work with the support of volunteers.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Coaching youth and adults with disabilities in the game of Baseball while developing the knowledge of the game, confidence, game strategies and skills;
- Establishing and maintaining a positive working relationship with the athletes, parents and volunteers involved in the program;
- Creating an environment that is inclusive and supportive;
- Communicating with athletes/parents/ guardians, volunteers;
- Coordinating the participation in tournaments, and the yearly Challenger Baseball National Jamboree at the Rogers Centre;
- Participating in Variety Village training initiatives including Health & Safety, AODA, and Plan to Protect;
- Participating in Variety's Orientation program and adhere to established organizational policies and protocols;
- Handling other duties as assigned.
