Summary:

Variety Village's Taekwondo program seeks qualified Instructors and coaches to assist in leading our Recreational and Competitive Taekwondo teams of all abilities. This is a part time, contract position, with opportunities for available Taekwondo programming during Summer & various Holiday Camps
